Research Grants

Research Grants up to \$25,000 are available to support oncology nursing research

Letter of Intent Due: August 15
Grant due: September 15

Dissertation Research Grant up to \$5,000 is available to support oncology nursing research for PhD dissertations.

Letter of Intent Due: June 1
Grant due: July 1

Career Development

End-of-Life Care Career Development up to \$2,500 is available to support continuing education activities for nurses working with patients in the final stages of life. Applications due: June 15

Josh Gottheil Bone Marrow Transplant Career Development \$2,000 is available to support continuing education activities of nurses working in BMT. Applications due: June 15

Pearl Moore Career Development up to \$3,000 is available to support continuing education activities for nurses in direct patient care. Applications due: June 15

Research Career Development \$20,000 is available to beginning researchers to support short-term oncology research training and mentorship. Applications due: July 1

Project Funding

Clinical Projects \$5,000 year/2 years is available for APN/DNP prepared nurses to conduct clinically based projects that promote patient, practice or system change. Applications due: See ONS Foundation website

APN/DNP Student Scholarship up to \$5,000 is available for APN/DNP students working on a capstone project or thesis. Applications due: See ONS Foundation website

Cancer Public Education Project up to \$5,000 is available for projects that enhance the public's knowledge and awareness of cancer prevention and detection. Applications due: June 15

Scholarships and Grants for ONS Chapters

Sandy Purl Mentorship Scholarship

Established by the Chicago Chapter of ONS

Scholarship: Up to \$1,000 support for scholarships that are awarded to an additional ONS Chapter member to attend the ONS Chapter Leadership Workshop. Applicant cannot be the sole member of the Chapter attending

Application Due Date: May 15, 2018

Eligibility: Must be a current ONS Chapter Board or committee member supported by a Chapter Leader Sponsor. (A Chapter Leader Sponsor is a current Chapter Board member that has agreed the applicant has the approval of the Chapter to attend).

- Chapter Leaders Sponsors may support more than one individual however grant is restricted to support only one individual.
- Applicant must share their goal for attending the Chapter Leadership Workshop and how they plan to use the information they gained by attending.
- Applicant must identify the other Chapter member that is attending the Chapter Leadership Workshop.

Breast Cancer Community Education Grants for ONS Chapters

Funded by the ONS Foundation through a grant from AstraZeneca HealthCare Foundation.

Purpose: To increase breast cancer awareness in communities by supporting nurse directed patient and community focused educational programs.

Grant: Up to \$1,000 is available to qualified ONS Chapters across the United States to plan and implement patient/community focused breast cancer education/awareness programs.

Application Due Date: Open applications accepted but must be received by the ONS Foundation no later than 2 weeks prior to program start date. Application will remain open until funds are expended.

Eligibility:

- Program must be an ONS Chapter activity and focus on community education.
- Grant is not intended to support work based community education programs. Program cannot limit attendance to an institution, hospital or hospital network, or nurse work setting.
- Individual programs and/or Chapters can only receive one grant.
